All of our frames are handmade and constructed from high quality acetate combined beautifully with gold color plated metal pieces. The brand's signature color - Japanese gold- is used, which can be seen in virtually all of Nathalies' previous designs including her clothing line. Why this particular color? For Nathalie, each and ever\y color and tone are like the sound of a particular instrument. Japanese gold, is the sound of a cello that is playing modern tunes from inspired classical pieces. The Model Linen - Slightly oversized acetate sunglasses characterized by refine touch of an iconic metallic accent coated in Japanese gold color which is a very subtle mixture of silver and gold color in matte texture on the outer corner.
